About the apprenticeship

You will study towards a BSc (Hons) Digital and Technology Solutions degree at MK:U - Cranfield University's undergraduate brand; backed by government and business. This new kind of university was designed with business and inspired by new technologies.

Education at MK:U is different from other universities. Instead of traditional lectures and exams, MK:U's entire curriculum uses problem-based learning (PBL) as their core educational approach. You will spend 20% of your time studying with MK:U and the other 80% developing your career with us. The duration of the course is 3 years 8 months.

During your apprenticeship, you will gain exposure, personal development, and experience within a wide range of technical areas at Resonate, growing your personal network and enabling us to collaboratively work out your career preferences and future direction.

Your work role will directly relate to your degree and therefore you will need to have a keen interest in technology and a willingness to learn about the benefits it can deliver for society, the economy and sustainability.

What you will get

Not only will your tuition fees be fully covered but you will also get paid a salary for working and studying. Location

Entry requirements

- We welcome applications from talented candidates of all backgrounds and ages
- To have or be predicted to achieve a minimum of 96 UCAS points (three C grades at A-Level/ BTECs at grade C or above, or an equivalent academic or professional qualification) - other relevant or prior experience may be considered as an alternative

To be considered, you must also:

- Have left full-time education when the apprenticeship starts
- Have the right to work in the UK
